Each year Don King Days is considered by over a thousand spectators to be the western grand finale of summer fun! This year marks the 20th annual [Don King Days](#) at the Big Horn Events Center, Sunday and Monday of Labor Day Weekend, August 31 & September 1, 2008.

Events feature classic equine events like polo, steer roping, bronc riding and wild cow milking, beginning both days at 11 a.m. The Big Horn Events Center's few fences and big fields put the crowd right in the middle of all the action. Sunday features polo, the first rounds of the Wyoming Steer Roping Finals and wild cow milking. Taking place on Monday are polo, steer roping and the matched bronc riding.

Each day, following the events "on the grass", there will be live music. One of the country's premier acoustic guitarists, Jalan Crossland, will perform. Jalan's extraordinary guitar work has earned National Fingerstyle Championship honors in 1997 and the Wyoming State Championship Flatpick Title in 1999. Additional information regarding performers TBA.

The Don King Days events began when local ranchers came up with this unique combination of equestrian events to be held in honor of King, owner of King's Saddlery and renowned saddle maker world-wide.
