Visitors to Sheridan, Wyoming this holiday season will find plenty of reasons for Christmas cheer. The 13th Annual Christmas Stroll, the beginning of a month-long celebration and one of northern Wyoming's largest retail promotions of the year, kicks off in Sheridan the day after Thanksgiving. The 2008 theme is *The Magic of Christmas*, and shoppers "stroll" the streets, visiting over 100 participating businesses while enjoying a variety of festivities.

A huge fireworks display serves as the grand finale for a memorable evening.
