Play it . . . Wyoming's Golf Capital with deer, antelope and 81 holes of world-class golf !

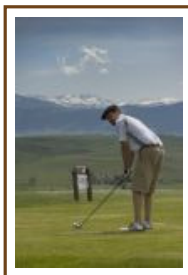
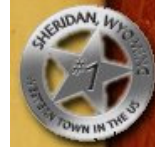
