The Bradford Brinton Memorial & Museum's 17th Annual Holiday Show opens November 24th and runs through December 22nd. This year's exhibition is a one-person show titled Native American Images Series - Rendering Levels of Reality: Paintings by James F. Jackson.



Jackson has exhibited at the Museum in several one-man and group shows featuring his unique artistic style in painting and leatherwork. For this show he chose to focus on "the image of the Native American because I sense in their culture a beautiful simplicity." The artist reaches further by "taking artistic liberty to arrange and create a reality that is dictated more by the design, color, and rendering methods than the subject matter. These methods and processes are the real subject matter and the heart (poetic soul) of my visual work."
