At times Orchard Fire is reminiscent of Tom Petty's Heartbreakers being fronted by Miranda Lambert. The heart of this band are the songs that when stripped down to just Melissa Odom's expressive alto, her acoustic guitar, the fiddle, and the mandolin, are patently country, almost bluegrass at times..
